The Barnet (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (No.1) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 200* **The Barnet (Chipping Barnet) (On-Street Parking Places) (No.1) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 200***

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 51 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The general effect of the Orders would be to provide disabled parking bays for vehicles displaying a valid disabled Blue Badge at the following locations:

16 Bohun Grove, East Barnet; 21 Brunswick Avenue, N11; 47 Colin Gardens, NW9; 33b Capel Road, East Barnet; 106 Engel Park, NW7; 43 Green Walk, NW4; 66 Halliwick Road, N10; 10 Hillview Gardens, NW4; Holmwood Gardens, side of 55 Mountfield Road, N3; 140 Mount Pleasant, New Barnet; 195 Squires Lane, N3; 9 The Drive, Barnet; 6 Westbury Road, N12 and 8 Woodlands, NW11.

The bay at 9 The Drive, Barnet would be provided by converting an existing resident permit parking space.

The proposed parking bays would operate at all times, with the exception of the bay located in Holmwood Gardens, side of 55 Mountfield Road, N3 which would have a maximum stay of 2 hours, Mondays to Fridays between 7.45am and 6.00pm, with no return allowed within 1 hour.

It is also proposed to remove the following redundant disabled parking bays:

50 Ashurst Road N12, 12 Burnbrae Close N12, 114 East End Road N3, 3 Graywood Court N12, 82 Heath View N2, 21 Lankaster Gardens N2 and 71 Worcester Crescent NW7.

A copy of the proposed Orders, a plan of the relevant locations and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected between 9am and 5pm Mondays to Fridays (Public and Bank Holidays excepted) inclusive for a period of 28 days from the date on which this notice is published at the Design Team, Building 4, North London Business Park, Oakleigh Road South, London, N11 1NP; and the Information Centre, The Town Hall, The Burroughs, Hendon, London, NW4 4BG.
