**Temporary Traffic Prohibitions**

**Brookside Road and Highfield Road NW11**

The BARNET LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to the need to facilitate the installation of a flood alleviation scheme, they intend to make an Order which will:

- 1) close Brookside Road between its junctions with Highfield Road and Sneath Avenue, while the works take place; and
- 2) prohibit the waiting and loading of vehicles, at all times, on both sides of Highfield Road, between its junction with Brookside Road, and its north-easternmost point, while the works take place.

The Order will commence on Monday 26 November 2007 at 8am and is expected to last for twenty weeks.

The closure will occur at various stages and will take place in various sections of Brookside Road, the alternative routes for motorists will be indicated by appropriate signage when the closures are in effect.

Nothing in the above paragraphs shall apply to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
