NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above mentioned Orders under Sections 45, 46 49, 51, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The general effect of the Orders would be to make changes to the on-street parking layout within the Hendon, Golders Green and Cricklewood Controlled Parking Zones as follows:

1. the resident permit parking place outside Nos. 28 to 30 Glebe Crescent NW4 would be reduced in length in order to accommodate an access to off-street parking facility at No. 30 Glebe Crescent.
2. the resident permit parking place outside No. 91 West Heath Road NW3 would be reduced in length to accommodate accesses to an off-street parking facility at No. 91 West Heath Road.
3. the resident parking place outside Nos. 46 to 52 Dersingham Road NW2 would be reduced in length in order to accommodate an access to an off-street parking facility at No. 48 Dersingham Road.
4. the resident permit parking place opposite Nos. 28 and 30 Hocroft Road NW2 would be reduced in length to accommodate an access to an off-street parking facility at No. 28 Ranulf Road NW2.

Copies of the proposed Orders, a plan of the relevant areas and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at:
