NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 51 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The general effect of the Orders would be to provide disabled parking bays for vehicles displaying a valid disabled Blue Badge at the following locations:

51 Avondale Avenue, East Barnet; outside Mulberry Court, Bedford Road, N2; 1/2 Brent View Road, NW9; 33 Burnbrae Close, N12; 16 Clifton Road, N3; 112 Clitterhouse Road, NW2; 175 Colin Crescent, NW9; 11 Derby Avenue, N12; 85 Friern Barnet Road, N11; 1 Glebe Road, N3; 13/15 Glenhurst Road, N12; 51/53 Heath View, N2; 15 Whiteways, Hillview Gardens, NW4; 4 Johns Avenue, NW4; 1 Esmond Court, Prospect Road, New Barnet; 12a Ravenshurst Avenue, NW4; 11 Snowden Drive, NW9; opposite Sunnyside House, Sunnyside NW2; 15 Talbot Avenue, N2; 83 Wentworth Avenue, N3 and Fellowship House, 136a Willifield Way, NW11.

The bay outside Mulberry Court, Bedford Road, N3 would be provided by converting an existing pay and display parking space.

The bays at 1/2 Brent View Road NW9, 11 Derby Avenue N12, 13/15 Glenhurst Road N12, 4 Johns Avenue NW4, 12a Ravenshurst Avenue NW4, opposite Sunnyside House, Sunnyside NW2 and 15 Talbot Avenue N2, would be provided by converting existing permit parking spaces.

The proposed parking bays would operate at all times, with the exception of the bay located at Fellowship House, 136a Willifield Way, NW11, which would have a maximum stay of 3 hours, between 9.00am and 9.00pm, with no return allowed within 1 hour.

It is also proposed to remove the following redundant disabled parking bays and where noted convert to permit or free parking places:

78 Balfour Grove N20, 21 Brunswick Avenue N11, 58 Cranbrook Road East Barnet, 5 Ferney Road East Barnet, 14 Frith Court NW7, 43 Glenthorne Road N11, opposite 15 Heather Gardens NW11 (convert to resident permit parking space), 38 Hillview Gardens NW4, 111 Leslie Road N2, 7 Marlborough Gardens N20, 3 Marriott Road Barnet (convert to resident permit parking space), 37 Park Road NW4, 88 Pembroke Road N10, 20 Princes Avenue N3 (convert to resident permit parking space), 29 Russell Road NW9 (convert to resident permit parking space), Sheaveshill Avenue NW9 outside Sheaveshill House (convert to resident permit parking space), 84 Sheaveshill Avenue NW9, 5 Sunny Way N12, 21 Sunny Way N12, 51 Sutton Road N10, Widcombe Way 2 bays outside Widcombe Court (convert to free parking spaces), and 52a Wilton Road N10.
