**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE
ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991 - SECTION 14(1)**

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

Hampstead Lane, Spaniards Road and North End Way NW3

The BARNET LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that due to the expected large numbers of vehicles and pedestrians expected to attend the Kenwood Concerts they have made an Order which will introduce various prohibitions and restrictions intended to maintain pedestrian and vehicular safety while the Kenwood Concerts are in effect:

1. Subject to the following provisions of this Order, no person shall, when concerts and events are taking place within the grounds of Kenwood House and between the hours of 6.00pm and midnight, cause any vehicle to :
 - a. enter Spaniards Road in a north-easterly direction from its junction with North End Way and Heath Street.
 - b. park on the restricted area indicated by cones on the junction of Bishops Avenue and Hampstead Lane.
 - c. turn right out of Columbas Drive into Spaniards Road
 - d. turn right out of Mount Tyndal into Spaniards Road
 - e. turn left out of Spaniards End into Spaniards Road
 - f. proceed along Spaniards Road in a north-easterly direction from the north-eastern kerbline of Columbas Drive to a point opposite The Spaniards Inn Public House and Toll Gate House
2. The prohibition specified in Article (1) of this Order shall apply only during such times as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

This Order will be made with the permission of the London Borough of Camden who is the highway authority for some of the roads.

The restrictions will commence on Saturday 28th June 2008 at 6pm and come into effect for each event held at Kenwood House where it is necessary to control the movement of vehicles attending and leaving the event. The controls will operate between 6.00pm and midnight when indicated by the presence of signs and cones.

Nothing in the above paragraphs shall apply to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform
