NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above mentioned Orders under Sections 45, 46 49, 51, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The general effect of the Orders would be to make changes to the on-street parking layout within the Brent Cross Station, Hendon and Mill Hill Controlled Parking Zones as follows:

1. the resident permit parking place outside Nos. 97 to 101 Highfield Avenue NW11 would be reduced in length in order to accommodate an access to an off-street parking facility at No. 101 Highfield Avenue
2. the resident permit parking place on Hamilton Road NW11 outside No. 74 Hamilton Road and by the side of No. 83 Montpelier Rise NW11 would be reduced in length in order to accommodate an access to an off-street parking facility at No. 74 Hamilton Road.
3. the resident permit parking place outside Nos. 54 and 56 Sevington Road NW4 would be reduced in length in order to accommodate an access to an off-street parking facility at No. 54 Sevington Road.
4. the resident permit parking place outside No. 3 Eversfield Gardens NW7 would be removed in order to accommodate an access to an off-street parking facility at No. 3 Eversfield Gardens.

Copies of the proposed Orders, plans of the relevant areas and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at:
