Interested parties have the right to make a representation, either supporting or objecting to an application. Interested parties are people living or working in the vicinity of the premises concerned. There is no rigid definition of what 'in the vicinity' means, but as a general rule people need to show that they will be personally affected if the licence is granted. Anonymous representations cannot be accepted. Relevant representations must relate to the likely affect of granting the licence on one or more of the four licensing objectives:

- the prevention of nuisance
- the protection of children from harm
- public safety
- the prevention of crime and disorder.

Any person making a relevant representation may be asked to produce supporting evidence.

If there are no representations the council must grant the licence. If a relevant representation is received the council will arrange a licensing sub-committee hearing at which all parties may speak. An interested party may speak at the hearing, or may ask someone to speak for them. Late representations cannot be accepted, and matters not included in the original representation cannot be raised at the hearing.
