Summary Key Facts

- Coppetts has a higher than average proportion of its population who are middle aged and a lower proportion in the over 65 age group
- The ward has the highest proportion of Mixed White and Asian residents, 1.4% (200)
- A higher proportion of Coppett's workers than any Barnet ward use buses to get to work, 14.5% (1,029) and a lower proportion than any other ward work from home
- One in four of Coppetts' households comprise one person under retirement age, the highest in Barnet

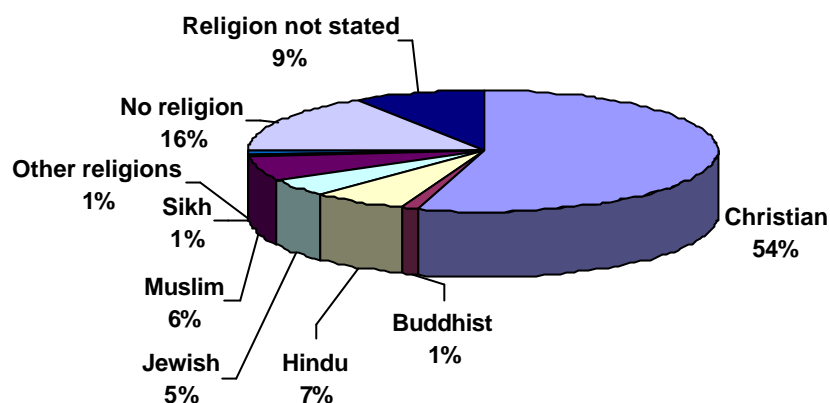
