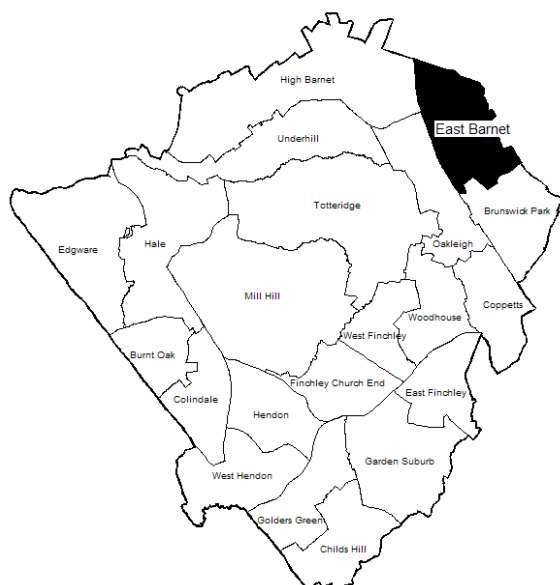


East Barnet



Key 2001 Census Statistics

The 2001 Census provides a uniquely accurate and comprehensive picture of the borough. This ward profile is one of a set of 21 compiled to help local analysis and comparisons. Each table gives the number and percentage of the ward's residents, households or dwellings that fall into a variety of categories and ranks the per cent with the other Barnet wards, giving the overall Barnet percentage

All data in this profile is drawn from the 2001 Census.

Summary Key Facts

- At 83%, East Barnet has the second highest proportion of its residents born in the United Kingdom
- Three-quarters of the ward's residents are White British, again the second highest rate in the borough
- At 62.8% of residents, East Barnet also has the second highest Christian population; and the lowest proportion not stating their religion
- A higher proportion of East Barnet workers are employed in the construction industry than any other of Barnet's wards
- East Barnet has a comparatively low proportion of residents who have never worked or are long-term unemployed
- With two mainline stations in the ward, East Barnet has the highest proportion of workers using trains to get to work: 10.4%
- 44.3% of East Barnet households own their property with a mortgage or loan, the second highest proportion in Barnet

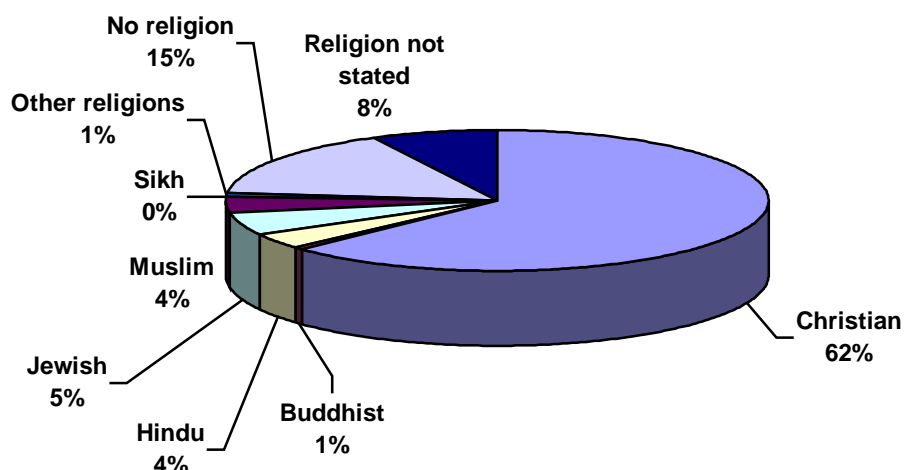
