Summary Key Facts

- Hale is in the middle of the range on most of the indicators
- Hale has the third highest percentage of 16 to 74 year olds in the *small employer, own account worker and lower supervisory and technical socio-economic* category
- It is the ward with the highest proportion of workers who travel to work by car, van, motor bike or taxi, 54.2%
- Hale has the largest proportion of semi-detached dwellings in the borough, 49.7% compared with a borough total of 31.2%

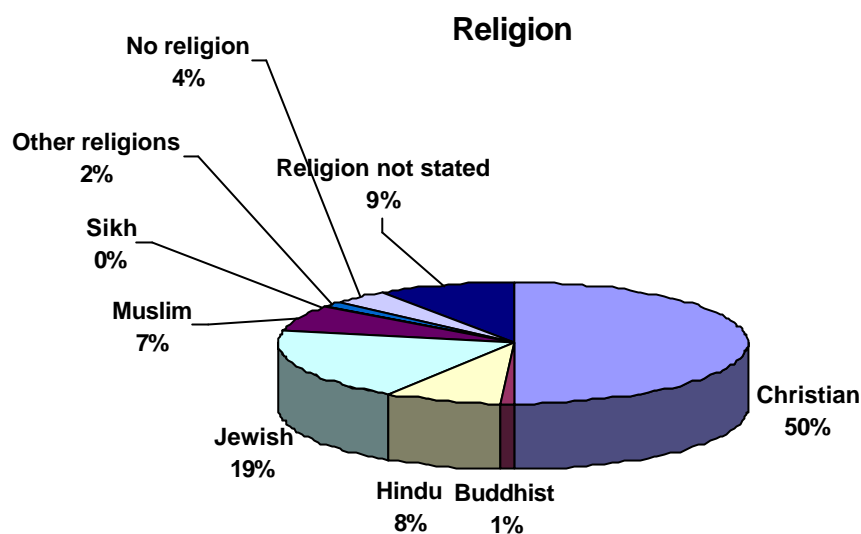
