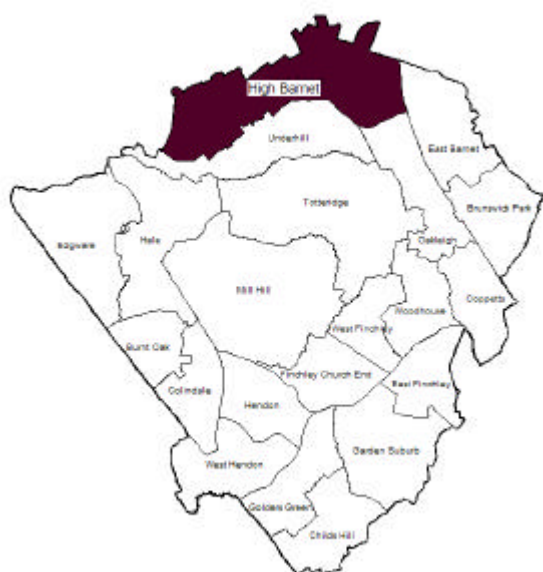

Summary Key Facts

- High Barnet has the second smallest population in the borough, 13,847
- The ward also has, at 8.7%, the second highest proportion of people aged 75 and above
- A greater proportion of High Barnet's population was born in England than any other Barnet ward – 84.4%
- High Barnet has, at 80%, the largest proportion of residents who classify themselves as White British
- In terms of their occupation, 11.2% of High Barnet residents aged 16 to 74 work in Education, the highest for this occupation group in Barnet
- High Barnet has the highest per cent of its work force in the Lower Managerial, Professional and Intermediate socio-economic class

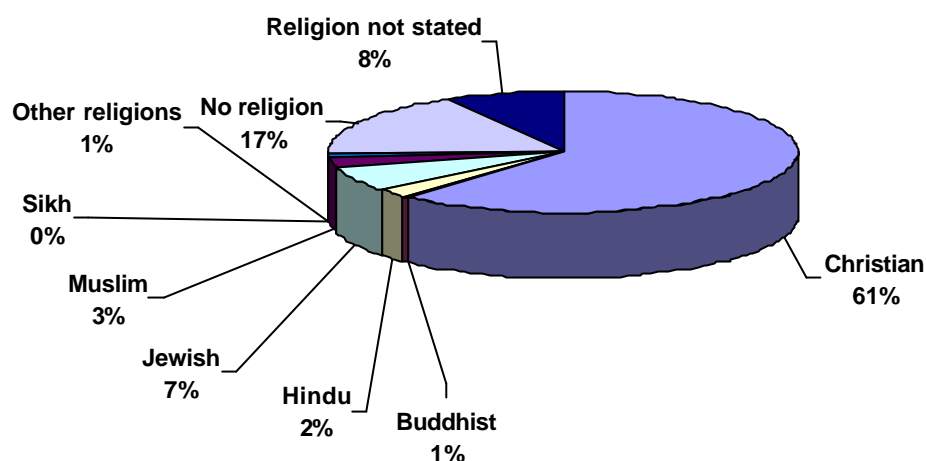
