Summary Key Facts

- Mill Hill is the geographically largest of Barnet's wards with 9.4 square kilometres
- This ward has the second highest proportion of its 16 to 74 year old population who are self-employed (15.9%) and the lowest proportion working in manufacturing
- At 10.3%, Mill Hill has the highest proportion of those travelling to work on foot or by bicycle
- A fifth of Mill Hill's dwellings are detached – the second highest proportion on Barnet
- Mill Hill has over twice the Barnet average proportion of vacant household dwellings, 6.7%

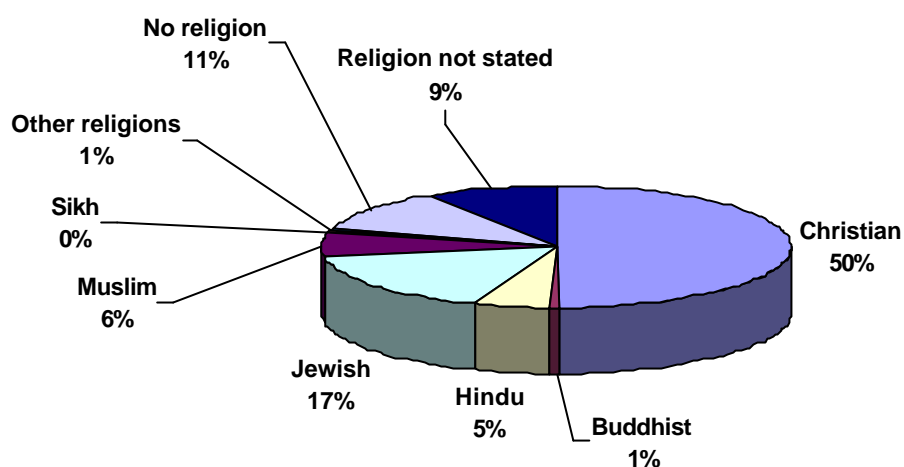
