#### Key 2001 Census Statistics

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#### Summary Key Facts

- Of Barnet wards, Underhill has the third highest proportion of its population born in England (82%) and the third highest proportion describing themselves as White British (75%)
- At 64.9%, Underhill has the highest proportion of Christians of Barnet's wards
- 13.4% of Underhill workers are in the Health and Social Work sector, the second highest for this sector in Barnet
- 27.5% of Totteridge's working age population have no qualification (the second highest rate in Barnet) and the ward has the third highest proportion of workers in the Semi-routine and Routine socio-economic category
- Very few people in Underhill rent from private landlords but it is the ward with the third highest rate of council renting
- At 14.2% of households Underhill has the third highest rate of lone parentage in Barnet

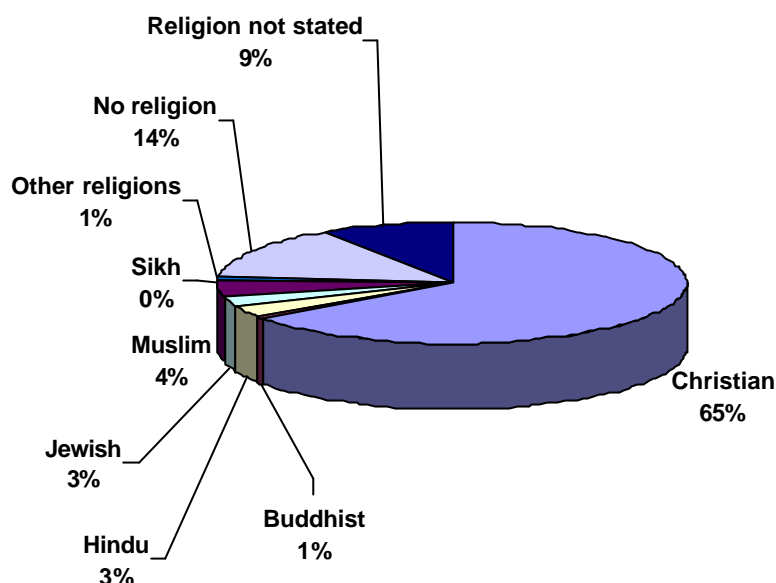
