ABANDONED SHOPPING AND LUGGAGE TROLLEYS

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990, SECTION 99

Notice of consultation on the adoption of Schedule 4 to the Environmental Protection Act 1990 (as amended by the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005)

The London Borough of Barnet, in pursuance of section 99 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 (the "1990 Act"), is proposing to adopt Schedule 4 to the 1990 Act (as amended) to apply in the borough of Barnet. Schedule 4 empowers a local authority, which has adopted it, to seize a shopping or luggage trolley which appears to be abandoned and remove it to such place under its control as the authority thinks fit. Schedule 4 also allows a local authority to retain, return, charge for or dispose of removed trolleys.

The council is, therefore, asking for the views/comments of borough residents, businesses and partners in relation to this proposal. To submit your views/comments for consideration, please complete a questionnaire which has been designed to help you to express your views/comments.
