Consultation Statement

This statement has been prepared in relation to the above regulations. The statement sets out the consultation strategy implemented by the Council to ensure compliance with the regulations.

The *Draft Supplementary Planning Document* and its associated *Sustainability Appraisal Report* have been subject to public consultation in accordance with national guidance. The SPD consultation period of 6 weeks lasted from 12th March and 23rd April 2007. It involved a press notice, website, libraries and direct e-mails to 234 organisations, including statutory consultees, councillors, local MPs, community groups and residents' associations.

The six weeks of public consultation generated 6 responses from a range of stakeholders including statutory consultees, consultants and local community groups. A summary of their representations is provided in the Representations Statement. The Statement sets out the council's response to each representation and makes appropriate recommendations on amending the SPD where necessary. In total 5 stakeholders made 31 representations, of which 19 were accepted and resulted in changes to the draft SPD. General issues raised included large development proposals, assessment of capacity, financial contribution per unit of affordable housing, monitoring and project management and educational contributions. The Council has considered these objections and in response has proposed revisions to the SPD as set out in the Representations Statement. The Council has also made a number of minor updates to the SPD and the Sustainability Appraisal during the consultation period.
