**THE HANDLING, WRAPPING & DELIVERY OF FOOD
& THE SALE OF FOOD IN THE OPEN AIR**

1972

BYELAW relating to the handling, wrapping and delivery of food and the sale of food in the open air made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the London Borough of Barnet, acting by the Council of the said Borough, under Section 15 of the Food and Drugs Act, 1955.

Revocation of byelaws

The Byelaws relating to the observance of sanitary and cleanly conditions and practices in connection with the handling, wrapping and delivery of food sold or intended for sale for human consumption, and in connection with the sale or exposure for sale in the open air of food intended for human consumption which were made by:-

1. the Urban District Council of Barnet on the 21st day of August, 1950, and were confirmed by the Minister of Food on the 23rd day of October, 1950;
2. the Urban District Council of East Barnet on the 17th day of July, 1950, and were confirmed by the Minister of Food on the 9th day of October, 1950;
3. the Urban District Council of Friern Barnet on the 30th day of March, 1950, and were confirmed by the Minister of Food on the 30th day of May, 1950;
4. the Finchley Borough Council on the 24th day of May, 1950, and were confirmed by the Minister of Food on the 24th day of July, 1950;

5. the Hendon Borough Council on the 12th day of December, 1950, and were confirmed by the Minister of Food on the 21st day of February, 1951,

are hereby revoked.
