This course aims to raise awareness of the new legislation regarding joint working with children and families and to prepare participants / practitioners to understand how they may contribute to the process. The course will also help practitioners to understand their own role in relation to safeguarding children in light of the changes brought about by the Laming Report following the death of Victoria Climbié.

**By the end of the course participants will:**

- Have an awareness of the recent changes in national legislation and government guidance in relation to children and how it relates to the support your service offers to families.
- Understand the background to and rationale for the six key areas of expertise (Common Core of Skills and Knowledge) for all practitioners working with children and families
- Consider how the skills and knowledge required by the Common Core fit into the context of their everyday practice.
- Have an awareness of the Common Assessment Framework (CAF) and how it fits into the whole Integrated Working (IW) strategy for practitioners working with children and families
- Have an understanding of how CAF can fit into the context of their day to day practice and how they can support the CAF process and/or signpost appropriately.

**Relevant service objectives:** Embedding integrated working practices across the partnership in Barnet including meeting the CWDC Common Induction Standards and the DfES Common Core of Skills and Knowledge proposal for all those working with children and young people.

**Audience:** All those working with children and young people in support roles including schools and other support staff.
