

LONDON BOROUGH OF BARNET

The Barnet (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No. 1) (Amendment No. **) Traffic Order 20**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by Section 8 and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.

Wessex Gardens School NW11 has recently developed a School Travel Plan (STP). This is a document developed by schools that aims to introduce a range of practical measures to encourage walking, cycling and using public transport on the journey to and from school.

There have been a number of safety concerns raised including double parking during school times. If problem is left unaddressed this would compromise sight lines and the safety of pupils crossing the road at a new crossing point with dropped kerbs.

As a consequence the London Borough of Barnet is proposing a number of traffic management measures in the area to enhance safety and the general pedestrian environment. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce a Monday to Friday 8am to 9.45am, 12midday to 1.30pm and 2.45pm to 4.15pm school keep clear 'no stopping' restrictions outside Nos. 47, 49 and 51 Wessex Gardens, in order to deter motorists from stopping near a crossing point.

A copy of the proposed Order, a plan of the relevant area and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at:
