

LONDON BOROUGH OF BARNET

The Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 20****

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

As part of a London Bus Priority Network scheme some measures have been identified to improve bus accessibility along the 384 bus route, and reduce traffic delay, congestion and improve safety. The general effect of the Order would be to provide waiting restrictions on Longmore Avenue, East Barnet, as follows:

- At any time waiting restrictions would be provided on the southern side of Longmore Avenue, East Barnet, opposite Nos. 30 and 32 Longmore Avenue, in order to provide a clear approach for buses approaching a proposed bus stop opposite Nos. 32, 34 and 36 Longmore Avenue.
- At any time waiting restrictions would be provided on the northern side of Longmore Avenue outside Nos. 34, 36 and 38 Longmore Avenue, East Barnet, in order to deter parked vehicles from parking opposite the proposed bus stop clearway to allow an unhindered traffic flow in both directions in the vicinity of the bus stop clearway.

A copy of the proposed Order, a plan of the relevant areas and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at:
