THE BARNET (HAMPDEN SQUARE) (GOODS VEHICLES) (LOADING PLACES) TRAFFIC ORDER 201*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 51, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The general effect of the Parking Places Order would be to introduce short-term pay and display parking places on Hampden Square N14 in order to provide a parking facility for motorists wishing to visit local shops and amenities, as the current situation of parked vehicles all day prevents those wishing to visit local shops and amenities, which has subsequently had a negative effect on the local businesses who rely on passing trade.

Due to the types of shops and amenities in the area, a tariff varied from that applicable on-street in the rest of the borough is considered to be beneficial to ensure that the area will remain amenable to visiting motorists, and therefore the following charges will apply between 8am and 6pm, Mondays to Saturdays:

Up to 30 minutes - Free
Up to 1 hour - 50p
Up to 3 hours - £1.00

The general effect of the Loading Places Order would be to allow dedicated spaces for vehicles servicing the local shops to load and unload without hindering the passage of traffic on the highway.

Copies of the proposed Orders, a plan of the relevant area and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays (Bank Holidays and Public Holidays excepted) inclusive for a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published by contacting:
