and Directions) (England) Regulations 2000**

**Register of Electors: Publication of Verification
Number for Mayoral Petition**

The Local Government Act 2000, and the Local Authority (Referendums) (Petitions and Directions) (England) Regulations 2000 give electors of Barnet the opportunity to petition the Council to hold a referendum on whether or not the Borough should have a directly elected Mayor.

To be valid the petition must be signed by not less than 5% of the registered local government electors in the Borough on 15th February. The annual revised register is now published on 1st December, but can be updated on the 1st day of every month from January to September. The 5% electorate figure therefore must be that eligible on 1st February.

The number of local government electors equal to 5% of those registered on **1st February 2010** is **11,729**. This figure will be used to determine if a petition made between **1st April 2010** and **31st March 2011** is valid.
