**TEMPORARY WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS
Grahame Park Way NW9**

The BARNET LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing for the need to facilitate access for large vehicles removing spoil from, and facilitating construction of a rail track sub-station, they intend to make an Order which will:

1. prohibit waiting and loading by vehicles at all times on the north-western side of Grahame Park Way NW9 between a point opposite the south-eastern kerbline of Avion Crescent, and a point 50 metres south of that point, while the works take place
- (b) prohibit waiting and loading by vehicles at all times on the south-eastern side of Grahame Park Way NW9 between the south-eastern kerbline of Avion Crescent, and a point 35 metres south of that kerbline, while the works take place

The Order will commence at 8am on Monday 8th February 2010 and is expected to last for four months.

Nothing in the above paragraphs shall apply to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable, a Civil Enforcement Officer or a Traffic Warden in uniform.
