### STATUTORY CONSULTATION SCHOOL ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2011 to 2012

As per the School Organisation and Governance (Amendment)(England) Regulations 2009 all admissions authorities must consult on school admissions arrangements and application processes.

The consultation concerns the school admission arrangements for all maintained schools (Community, Voluntary Aided and Foundation) in the London Borough of Barnet as well as the two Academies. This consultation includes any aspect of the Council's admission arrangements but in particular concerning the following:

- Admission policies and oversubscription criteria, which determine how places are allocated when there are more applications than places available at a particular school.
- Proposed changes to the in-year admission arrangements and introduction of a co-ordinated scheme for in-year admissions
- The co-ordinated schemes for both Primary and Secondary schools. These schemes enable the Local Authority to co-ordinate the allocation of places on an equal preference basis to schools across London and the adjoining authorities.

The Local Authority welcomes your views on all matters relating to the statutory school admission arrangements for entry in September 2011.
