The Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 40) Traffic Order 2010

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet has made on 4th February 2010 the above-mentioned Order under Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The general effect of the Order will be to enable the Council to deter parking which currently occurs and obstructs the free flow of traffic by introducing 'at any time' waiting restrictions at the north-easternmost junction of Langford Crescent with Bevan Road, East Barnet, and at the junction of Hayward Road with Naylor Road N20.

A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on Saturday 22nd February 2010, plans of the relevant areas and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published at:

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
