NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet on 11 February 2010 have made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

In order to accommodate the introduction of 'dropped kerb' vehicle crossovers to enable access to off-street facilities, the general effect of the above Orders will be to modify the existing parking layout at the following locations, with a resultant loss of parking spaces as follows:

Outside No. 39 Sandringham Gdns.,N12	Free bay	One
Outside No. 26 Nant Road, NW2	Resident permit bay	One
Outside No. 13 Castle Road, N12	Resident permit bay	One

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
