Nomination Papers may be obtained on any day (*except Saturdays, Sundays or any Bank or Public holiday*) between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm from the Elections Office at the above address from the undersigned who will, at the request of any local government elector for the said Wards, prepare a Nomination Paper for signature.
4. If an election in any Ward is contested, the Polling Stations in that Ward will be open from **7:00am to 10:00pm on Thursday 6 May 2010**.
5. Electors and their proxies should note that to be effective at this election:
- Applications to vote by post at this election, or changes or cancellations to existing postal voting arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Building 4, North London Business Park, Oakleigh Road South, London, N11 1NP, by the statutory deadline of 5:00pm **on Tuesday 20 April 2010**.
 - Applications to appoint a person to vote as proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Building 4, North London Business Park, London, N11 1NP by the statutory deadline of 5:00pm **on Tuesday 27 April 2010**.
 - Applications to appoint a proxy as a result of a physical incapacity that occurred after 5:00pm on 27 April 2010, and suitably witnessed, can be made at any time before **5:00pm on polling day, Thursday 6 May 2010**.
