The Barnet (Brent Cross Station)(On Street Parking Places)(No. 1) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 200*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Sections 6, 45, 46 and 49 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

In order to cater for a known demand it is proposed to make amendments to the existing Brent Cross Station Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) in Golders Green.

The Brent Cross Station CPZ operates Monday to Friday 11am to Midday. The general effect of the above Order would be to convert two resident permit parking places in Wessex Way, two free parking places in Montpelier Way and a free parking place in Woodstock Avenue to Pay and Display parking places, which would result in the reduction of 12 resident permit parking spaces and 30 free parking spaces across the CPZ area. Loading and unloading would be permitted in these parking places without the need to display a pay and display ticket or disabled persons blue badge for up to twenty minutes, provided that the loading and unloading was seen to be continuous.

The proposed pay and display parking places would operate Monday to Friday 10am to 5pm. The charge for parking in these parking places would be £1.00 for a maximum period of six hours with no return allowed within one hour.

A copy of the proposed Order, a plan of the relevant area and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays (Bank Holidays excepted) inclusive for a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at:
