**The Barnet (North Finchley) (Off-Street Parking Places) (No.1)
(Amendment No. 1) Traffic Order 2008**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet on 11th September 2008 made the above-mentioned Order under Sections 35 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers

The general effect of the Order will be to reduce the operational hours of the Stanhope Road N12 (Main), Stanhope Road N12 (Upper), Stanhope Road N12 (Bottom) and Castle Road N12 car parks, so they operate on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, between 8am and 5pm. The car parks are currently operational on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, between 8am and 6.30pm.

The reduction in the operational hours is intended to enable more local residents to use the car parks in the early evening.

Copies of the Order, which will come into operation on Monday 15th September 2008 and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays (Bank Holidays and Public Holidays excepted) for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published at:

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
