NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet have made on 16th August 2007 the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 51 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The general effect of the Orders will be to enable the provision of disabled parking bays for vehicles displaying a valid disabled Blue Badge at the locations detailed in part 1 below, and the removal of disabled parking bays as detailed in part 2 below:

Part 1:

58 East Crescent, N11; 5 Ferney Road, East Barnet; 41 Glenthorne Road, N11; 72 Golders Manor Drive, NW11; 118 Hampstead Way, NW11; 31 Holly Park Road, N11; 23 Lakeside Crescent, East Barnet; 21 Langham Gardens, Edgware; 18 Littlefield Road, Burnt Oak; 136 Littlefield Road, Burnt Oak; 22 Milesplit Hill, NW7; 18 Ravenshurst Avenue, NW4; 25 Stewards Holte Walk, The Avenue, N11; Sunny Hill Court, Sunningfields Crescent, NW4; Dolliscroft, Vineyard Avenue, NW7; 6 Shaftesbury Avenue, New Barnet; 82 Whitehouse Way, N14; 12 Woodville Road, New Barnet.

The bays at 72 Golders Manor Drive NW11 and 18 Ravenshurst Avenue NW4, will be provided by converting existing permit parking spaces.

The following redundant disabled parking bay will be removed and where noted converted to permit parking spaces:

Addison Way, outside Montrose Court, NW11, 82 Clitterhouse Crescent, NW2, 56 Glebe Road N3, 10 Goldsmith Road N11, 23 Grove Road New Barnet, 53 Hamilton Road NW11 (convert to permit parking space), 58 Kings Drive, Edgware, 99 North End Road NW11 (convert to permit parking space), 13 Rosemary Avenue N3, 18 Trinity Road N2, 126 Weirdale Avenue, N20.

Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2007, plans of the relevant areas and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays (Public and Bank Holidays excepted) for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published at:

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
