# THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARNET

## (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1970

The Council of the London Borough of Barnet (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1967 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

### Part I

#### GENERAL

1. (1) This Order shall come into operation on 1st January 1971, and may be cited as the London Borough of Barnet (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1970.

(2) The byelaws, made under section 68 of the Public Health Act, 1925 and having effect by virtue of section 110(2) of and paragraph 1 of Schedule 8 to the 1967 Act as if their provisions had been contained in an Order under Section 31(1) of the 1967 Act with respect to the parking places specified in Schedule 2 to this Order, are hereby revoked.

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"owner" has the same meaning as in section 104(1) of the 1967 Act; and

"parking place" means any area of land specified by name in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order provided by the Council under Section 28(1) of the 1967 Act for use as a parking place.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if for the purposes of section 38 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the byelaws revoked by Article 1 of this Order were Acts of Parliament thereby repealed.

## **Part II**

### **USE OF PARKING PLACES**

3. Each area of land specified by name in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order may be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place for such classes of vehicles and in such positions as are specified in relation to that area in the said Schedule.
4. Where in Schedule 1 to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place -
  - (a) unless it is of the specified class; or
  - (b) in a position other than that specified.
5. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order for longer than a maximum period of 24

hours and shall not within two hours of its leaving permit it to wait again in that parking place.

6. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in order to depart from the parking place.
7. No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
8. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of Article 4, Article 5 or Article 9 of this Order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place;

Provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a parking place in contravention of the provision of Article 4(b) of this Order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.

9. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to wait in a parking place unless the vehicle is licensed in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act, 1962 and unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act, 1960.

10. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place or in the case of danger of collision.
11. No person shall, except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council, drive any vehicle in a parking place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place.
12. No person shall in a parking place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.
13. No person shall in a parking place use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.
14. No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place -
  - (a) for sleeping or camping purposes;
  - (b) for cooking purposes; or
  - (c) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.

15. No person shall use a parking place as a means of passage proceeding from one road to another road.
16. Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of -
  - (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place, or
  - (b) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place,

no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle (i) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance, or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit, so indicated, or (ii) in a direction other than that specified, as the case may be.
17. In a parking place no person shall -
  - (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council;
  - (b) light of cause or permit to be lit any fire.
18. Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 8 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be.

19. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place by virtue of Article 8 of this Order, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
  
20. No person shall damage or remove any headboard provided at the entrance or exit or any car park.
