Title: London Borough of Barnet, Local Development Framework Core Strategy Issues and Options Paper - Consultation

Content: The Local Development Framework (LDF) will be the spatial development plan for Barnet and will set out the Council's vision for a successful city-suburb over next 15 years. The Unitary Development Plan will be replaced by the LDF comprising a number of documents, including the Core Strategy that sets out the long term spatial vision for Barnet and the strategic policies to deliver the vision. This is the issues and options stage and is required to be publicised to engage with partners, stakeholders, local residents before the preparation of a preferred options report and submission to the Secretary of State.
