

LONDON BOROUGH OF BARNET

The Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction)(Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 200***

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

As part of the London Buses Priority Network scheme some measures have been identified to improve bus accessibility along the 204 bus route, and to reduce traffic delay and congestion on the route. The general effect of the above Order would include the provision of waiting restrictions and bus stop clearways as follows:

- a) New At any time waiting restrictions would be introduced:
 - i) along certain lengths of Quakers Course NW9
 - ii) along the west side of Lanacre Avenue NW9 by its junction with Grahame Park Way
 - iii) along the north–west side of Grahame Park Way NW9 by its junction with the west side of Lanacre Avenue

- b) New Monday to Friday 8am to 6.30pm waiting restrictions would be introduced;
 - i) on the east side of Lanacre Avenue between its junctions with Grahame Park Way and Belvedere Strand
 - ii) on the north-west side of Grahame Park Way by its junction with the east side of Lanacre Avenue
 - ii) on the south-east side of Grahame Park Way between its junctions with Aerodrome Road and Lanacre Avenue
 - iv) completely around the island site on Grahame Park Way between its junctions with Aerodrome Road and Lanacre Avenue.

- c) A bus stop clearway would be introduced in Quakers Course to formalise the location of the existing bus stop area.

A copy of the proposed Order, a plan of the relevant areas and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at:
