The Barnet (Waiting and Loading Restriction)(Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 200***

The Barnet (Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools) (No.1) (Amendment No. **) Traffic Order 200*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned order under Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers

In order to prevent obstructive parking, and improve general road safety in the vicinity of Monkfrith School N14 the general effect of the Orders would be to relocate existing, and introduce new school entrance "no stopping" markings on Monkfrith Way, and to introduce new at any time waiting restrictions on certain lengths of Monkfrith Way including around its junction with Knoll Drive. The school entrance markings would prohibit the stopping of vehicles on Mondays to Fridays, between 8am and 9.30am and 2.45pm and 4.15pm.

It is considered that these measures are necessary as the existing parking arrangements make it difficult for pedestrians to cross Monkfrith Way safely. In addition, the Council intends to recruit a School Crossing Patrol Officer to assist pedestrians in crossing the road, and the position of the proposed crossing point for a new School Crossing Patrol Officer was chosen due to its proximity to the school, the desired crossing point of pedestrians and the optimal sight lines in both directions of the highway as opposed to the other locations considered.

It is considered that the proposed measures outlined above are fundamental in the success of the School Crossing Patrol.

A copy of the proposed Orders, a plan of the relevant areas and the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at:
