### **The Barnet (Loading Places) Traffic Order 2007**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet have made on Thursday 1 March 2007 the above Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 51, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

In order to address the congestion that occurs in certain roads adjacent to the existing HC2 Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) in Hendon, which operates Monday to Friday 10am to 5pm, and to satisfy a known demand, the Council will address the congestion caused by motorists parking all day by extending the existing Hendon HC2 CPZ to include additional roads or parts of roads as detailed below:

Roads added to the HC2 CPZ will be:

Sunningfields Road down as far as, but not including Sunny Hill Court

Sunny Gardens Road between the existing HC2 CPZ boundary and the common boundary of Nos. 52 and 54 Sunny Gardens Road

Nursery Walk

Fuller Street

Rowsley Avenue between its junction with Sunny Gardens Road and the common boundary of Nos. 1 and 3 Rowsley Avenue.

The On Street Parking Places Order will provide additional resident parking places, general permit parking places and pay and display parking places which indicate by the appropriate signage their use during their controlled hours by vehicles displaying either a valid residents' permit, visitor voucher, business permit or a pay and display ticket as appropriate. Loading and unloading in these parking places will be permitted without the need to display a permit, pay and display ticket or visitor voucher for up to twenty minutes, provided that the loading and unloading is seen to be continuous.

The Waiting and Loading Restriction Order will introduce yellow lines restrictions where parking places cannot be provided in certain lengths of road in the relevant areas, which will restrict parking during the hours that the particular CPZ operates.

The Waiting and Loading Restriction Order will also introduce "At Any Time" waiting restrictions at the following locations:

Fuller Street opposite Nos. 29 to 37

Sunningfields Road outside Nos. 30 to 34, No. 5, Nos. 48a to 54, Clarice Court to No. 23, Nos. 31 to St Annes Court and Nos. 98 to 100

Sunny Gardens Road outside Nos. 19 to 25, Nos. 32 to 34, Nos. 49 to 53 and outside The Garden Hospital

Rowsley Avenue outside No. 1 and Nos. 2 to 8 and at its junction with Sunny Gardens Road

Nursery Walk, at its junctions with Sunningfields Road and Sunny Gardens Road

These restrictions will prohibit parking at all times to maintain traffic flow, especially for emergency vehicles. For the same reasons, "At Any Time" waiting restrictions will be introduced at the following locations:

Downage, at its junction with Sherwood Road

Downage, at the bend in the road opposite No. 1 Downage

Meadow Drive at its junction with Sunny Gardens Road Fuller Street at its junction with Sunny Gardens Road.

The Loading Places Order will introduce a loading place outside Deborah Rayne House, 33b Sunningfields Road, for the use of any vehicle. This loading place can be used for loading and unloading only during the hours specified on the appropriate signage.

Holders of disabled persons blue badges and motorcycles are exempt from all parking charges. Resident permits cost £40 per year for the first vehicle and £70 each for the second and third vehicles. A maximum of three permits can be purchased per household. Business Permits cost £300 per year, and a maximum of 3 permits can be purchased per business. Visitor vouchers cost £10 per book of ten vouchers, with a maximum of 20 books per household per year. HC2 permits and visitor vouchers are valid throughout the whole HC2 area. Addresses which would be eligible for the issue of residents permits, visitor vouchers and business permits are:

Fuller Street, all properties

Nursery Walk, all properties

Rowsley Avenue, No. 1 and Nos. 2 to 8

Sunningfields Road, Nos. 5 to 57 and Nos. 16 to 134, including Danbury House, Clarice Court, Hendon Lodge, Field Court, Sunny Lodge, Deborah Rayne House, St Annes Court, Kingsmount Court and Nursery Walk Court

Sunny Gardens Road, Nos. 1 to 79 and Nos.10 to 52, including The Garden Hospital and Cheshunt House

The fees for pay and display parking are:-

Up to 15 minutes	£0.30
Up to 30 minutes	£0.50
Up to 45 minutes	£0.80
Up to 1 hour	£1.50
Up to 90 minutes	£2.50
Up to 4 hours	£3.00 *
Over 4 hours	£4.00

\* some pay and display bays will have a maximum stay period of 4 hours. The maximum stay permissible will be indicated by appropriate signage.

Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation for the purposes of issuing permits and vouchers, erecting of traffic signs and the placing of road markings on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2007 and for all other purposes on Monday 2 April 2007, a plan of the relevant areas and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders can be inspected

between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays (Bank Holidays and Public Holidays excepted) for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published at:

- a) Traffic and Development Section, London Borough of Barnet, Building 4, North London Business Park, Oakleigh Road South, London, N11 1NP.
- b) The information Centre, The Town Hall, The Burroughs, Hendon, London NW4 4BG.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
