



Barnet Youth Opportunity Fund Revenue Application 08/09

What's it about?

The Government is giving money to local authorities to develop youth banks so that young people aged between 13-19 (up to 25 for those young people with a learning disability) can make decisions about how money is spent on activities in their area. Barnet has been given £199,556 to spend by March 2009. Only young people can decide how this money gets spent.

Criteria

The YOF fund is for new activities or projects for young people in Barnet, it may mean that you need some equipment or specialists tutors to support the project and this would be considered as part of your proposal, but large capital spend cannot be considered. Proposals should consider how the activity or project will engage and reach a wide group of young people. Activities funded must take place by March 31st 2009 and reports submitted to demonstrate how many young people the funding will benefit.

Applications should consider:

- New activities for young people aged 13-19 (up to 25 for those young people with a learning disability)
- The activity must take place in Barnet
- Young People must be instrumental in the ideas and the application process
- The project should be inclusive and contribute to the Every Child

Matters Five outcomes: Be healthy, Stay safe, Enjoy and achieve, Make a positive contribution, Achieve economic well being.

How can I apply for the money?

There are no set limits to the amount you can ask for but it has to realistically match the cost of what you are asking to do with it and how many young people will be able to access it. Young people only are allowed to apply, but adults can help. You must have an organisation that is willing to put their name to the application in order for you to get the money, as they will be responsible for monitoring and reporting on the spending.
