Young Commissioners is a 9-month programme where you get to work with Barnet Council's professional commissioners to help design services for young people, achieve AQA certificates and gain skills for the future.

What are commissioners?

Commissioners help decide what services are available to young people in Barnet. They are in charge of deciding how these services are run, and who runs them. They design services and contracts, engaging with families to provide the support they need.

- To be able to spend an hour and a half every two weeks, virtually or in person, to participate in the programme
- To want to make a difference
