	<ul> <li>What worries might stop people from using these service? What can we say to help people who are worried?</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>What information should social workers and other staff know so they can help people use the service?</li> </ul>





	<ul> <li>What are the best ways to tell the service what we think? What are the best ways to make sure they are doing what they promise?</li> </ul>
	What will happen next?
	<ul> <li>The group gave lots of ideas about how to tell people about the service.</li> </ul>
Welcome Welcome	<ul> <li>They also gave lots of ideas about what kinds of things people want to know.</li> </ul>
	• These ideas will now be part of the <b>leaflets</b> , <b>website</b> and other ways that we tell people about the service.
	<ul> <li>The group said that staff should have training in different disabilities and needs.</li> </ul>
	• Staff will now be trained in different needs like learning disabilities, dementia and mental health.
	<ul> <li>The group said it would be good for people to stay involved and help the service get better.</li> </ul>
	• There will now be a user group for people to do this. This will start after October 2017.
