	• These ideas will now be part of the leaflets , website and other ways that we tell people about the service.
	 The group said that staff should have training in different disabilities and needs.
	• Staff will now be trained in different needs like learning disabilities, dementia and mental health.
	 The group said it would be good for people to stay involved and help the service get better.
	• There will now be a user group for people to do this. This will start after October 2017.
