How to get your Leisure Pass

If you are interested in activating a Barnet Leisure Pass membership you will need to:

Children in care, care leavers or foster carers:

email your full name and date of birth to: cs.leisurepass@barnet.gov.uk

Carers:

Report to reception staff at one of the above Barnet Leisure Centres between 9am – 5pm, Mon – Fri.

Your eligibility will be confirmed and further instructions on how to obtain your pass will be presented. The same process will apply for annual pass renewals.*

What will your Leisure Pass get you?

Free Swimming at Barnet Cophall, Finchley Lido and Church Farm Leisure Centres and concessionary discounts on a wide range of other activities.

If you wish to use your membership outside of Barnet Leisure Centres, please note free swimming only applies within stipulated times as part of the standard Better programme. In addition to any applicable discounts.

Rules for the scheme

- you must be 9 years old and over to go to into a Leisure Centre without an adult
- you are expected to follow the same rules as all other leisure centre users
- your Barnet Leisure Pass is only for you and not for anyone else
- you must present your membership card when requested by centre staff
- your pass will be reviewed annually*
- children in care placed outside the borough are still entitled to a pass; discounts/entitlements may vary at Better centres outside Barnet.
