How your waste helps others

Furniture that is fit for re-use is collected by a charity called ReStore Community Projects, which provides furniture for use by people on low incomes.

Paint is donated to community groups and used by the council to cover unsightly graffiti in the borough.

Engine Oil is reprocessed into low-grade fuel for burning in generators which can be found in schools and hospitals.
