ELECTION of LONDON ASSEMBLY MEMBER for the BARNET AND CAMDEN CONSTITUENCY of the GREATER LONDON AUTHORITY

1. In the event of a contest, the date of the poll will be **Thursday 2 May 2024**.
2. Nomination papers to stand as a candidate in the election for the Barnet and Camden Constituency's London Assembly Member are available at www.londonelects.org.uk/im-candidate/nominations or from the office of the Constituency Returning Officer, London Borough of Barnet, 2 Bristol Avenue, Colindale, London NW9 4EW on working days between the hours of 10am and 4pm.
3. Completed nomination papers must be delivered to the Constituency Returning Officer, London Borough of Barnet, 2 Bristol Avenue, Colindale, London NW9 4EW on any weekday from the date of this notice between the hours of 10am and 4pm, but **by no later than 4pm on Wednesday 27 March 2024**.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer in the local authority where the elector is eligible to be registered **by Tuesday 16 April 2024**. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
5. Applications to vote by post, or to change existing postal or proxy voting arrangements, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer in the local authority where the elector is registered **by 5pm on Wednesday 17 April 2024**. Applications for a postal vote can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote
6. New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer in the local authority where the elector is registered **by 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**. Applications for a proxy vote can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy arising *after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024* must reach the Electoral Registration Officer in the local authority where the elector is registered **by 5pm on Thursday 2 May 2024**.
8. Applications for Voter Authority Certificates or Anonymous Elector Documents must reach the Electoral Registration Officer in the local authority where the elector is registered **by 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate
