Brent Cross Thameslink –part of the Brent Cross Cricklewood Regeneration Programme Night time/weekend work & gate access off Brent Terrace

Further to the letter advising you of work commencing on 8th January 2019, I wish to inform you that we are undertaking work at night and weekends near to your property on the dates and times in the table below.

This involves building new accommodation for train staff and the replacement sidings which will support the new Brent Cross West Station.

To enable the existing north railway sidings to be moved and create the space needed for the new station, we need to change the track layout, install piles for signals and overhead line equipment.

The sidings work is being carried out by Network Rail and the train operating company accommodation building work by Graham Construction.

The work requires a variety of machines and equipment to be used including excavators, piling rigs, generators and lighting. Piling by its nature is a very noisy activity, with the noise levels you are likely to experience being dependent on your distance from the piling location.

Some disturbance is unavoidable but we are committed to making every effort to minimise unnecessary noise. As part of the Considerate Constructors Scheme personnel working on site are briefed to work as quietly as possible to minimise impact on the local community.


